### **✠Opening Prayer**

Christ has Risen, He has risen indeed! Come let us give thanks to the Lord, for God is good; God's steadfast love endures forever! This is the day the Lord has made; let us rejoice and be glad in it. Today the Stone is rolled away and we ask Lord that You remove our burdens of being confined to home. Take away our sadness of not being able to worship together in this Holy sanctuary, knowing that we are together with you Lord. Inspire us with the Holy Spirit and lift us up so we can rejoice in the resurrection, let us celebrate Life Eternal in the Kingdom of Heaven. Amen

### **✠Prayer of Confession**

## The Sacrament of Holy Communion

(From Immersed in the Splendor of God, Rev. Dr. F. Russ Mitman)

Leader: The peace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you.

**People: And also with you.**

Leader: This table is for all Christians who wish to know the presence of Christ and to share in the community of God's people, Life up your hearts.

**People: We lift them to the Lord!**

Leader: We praise you, O Christ for your resurrection triumph over the powers of sin and death, assuring us that, because you live, we shall live also and nothing can separate us from your love.

**People: Thanks be to God for giving us the victory!**

Leader: We remember your Passover communion with those gathered at table with you and recall your Easter encounter in the breaking of the bread with those you met on the road to Emmaus.

**People: Thanks be to God for giving us the victory!**

Leader: We rejoice in the dawning of new life you promise the world, offering hope to the hopeless, voice to the voiceless, justice to those who suffer injustice, peace to those who know no peace, health to those who have no health, and love for those who have no love.

**People: Thanks be to God for giving us the victory!**

Leader: We offer you these gifts, a sacrifice of our praise thanksgiving, praying that as we eat and drink at this joyous feast of resurrection our eyes may be opened, and we may know you with us I the breaking of this bread.

## ✠ Communion Prayer

Leader: We give you thanks Holy One, almighty and eternal God, always and everywhere, through Jesus Christ. We bless you for your continual love and care for every creature. Above all, we give you thanks for the gift of Jesus, who is the way, the truth, and the life. By his obedience to you, by his suffering on the cross, and his resurrection from the dead, he delivered us from the way of sin and death. We praise you that Jesus now reigns with you in glory and ever lives to pray for us. We thank you for the Holy Spirit, leading us into truth, defending us in adversity, and uniting us in one holy church. Therefore, with the entire company of saints in heaven and on earth, we worship and glorify you, God Most Holy.

## Jesus' Words of Institution

Leader: The Lord Jesus, on the night before he died, while they were eating, took a loaf of bread, and after blessing it, broke it, gave it to them, and said,  
“Take; this is my body.” Then Jesus took a cup and after giving thanks, gave it to them, and all of them drank from it. Jesus said to them, “This is my blood of the new covenant, which is poured out for many. Truly I tell you, I will never drink again of the fruit of the vine until the day when I drink it new in the Kingdom of God.”
